



Bobby Nelson Taylor

October 19, 1934 - April 14, 2024

Mr. Bobby Nelson Taylor, age 89, of Lake Spivey, passed away on April 14, 2024. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, whose legacy of love and service will forever be cherished by his family and friends.

Bobby was born on October 19, 1934, in Farmington, MS. He met the love of his life, Donna Taylor, and they were married in 1953. Bobby served his country with honor and dedication, joining the army and serving for 24 and a half years. Throughout his military career, he displayed courage and commitment, serving in various locations including the Panama Canal in 1955, Vietnam from 1967 to 1968 and 1972-1973, and at C Point Charlie on the Berlin Wall during the early 1960s. While serving his country honorably in the US Army he was awarded several awards and accommodations, including 2 Bronze Stars and The Legion of Merit.

Following his retirement from the army, Bobby embarked on a new chapter of his life, joining the executive management team at the Westin Peachtree Plaza. He dedicated 20 years of service to the hotel before retiring. Bobby was also a founding member of Tara Church of Christ, where he remained actively involved for many years.

Mr. Taylor is survived by his loving wife, Donna L. Taylor; his daughter, Terri Taylor-Hamrick; his son, Jeff "Bugs" Taylor (Marianne); his grandchildren, Gabe Hamrick (Carla), Nancy Harper, Jeffery Taylor, and AJ Taylor; his great-grandchildren, Bailey Taylor, Peyton Taylor, Grace Taylor, Jeffery Taylor,

Camden Taylor, Kellen Harper, and Dillon Harper; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
