Colonel Charles W. Scott, U.S. Army Retired, age 90 of Jonesboro, passed away December 30, 2022. He was a member of St. James the Apostle Catholic Church and was a retired Colonel, with the U.S. Army. Colonel Scott was a prisoner for 444 days in Iran and released in 1981. He was published author of his experiences in Iran in a book called "Pieces of The Game."
