“ Memories from Happy childhood days in Southwest Atlanta. I've known Bruce Sims since we were in Boy Scout Troop 81, behind the old West End Baptist Church up there at the corner of Lee @ Gordon in Atlanta before the new church was built next to the Wrens Nest. We used to ride our bicycles up through West End to Scout meetings in 1949. Around 1950... We moved the scout hut down Gordon Street to the new church in the middle of the night on a huge tractor trailer. Bruce, Pleamon Davis, Frank Rawlins, and Me were up on the roof with big 2x4's pushing the trolley power lines up higher so the rig could pass under. (we were all of 12 years old). We used to go on many camping trips as kids and I think I've got some pictures around of him and me up in Cherokee NC camped in tents along the Oconoluftee River. This was when he lived down on West View Dr. next door to Edna Stephens..(before his family ever moved up on Lawton along there across from Mary Lynn Summerlin). Bruce, Roy Hazelrig, Jack Bell, and Me used to run around together when we were all in Brown High School there in Atlanta. Harriett (formerly Harriett Crenshaw) and Bruce and I were in the same graduating class of 1956. I haven't seen his brother Bobby since we were kids.. During Navy days...Bruce was on the USS Oriskany (which was used in the filming of the William Holden movie "The Bridges at Toko-Ri"). I was there in the Pacific also over on the USS Lexington.
