Stephanie Lozel, age 72, of Jonesboro, Georgia, passed away on Friday, February 7, 2025.

Born on December 12, 1952, in Manchester, Ohio, Stephanie was the daughter of the late Elizabeth Owens and Stephen Olah. She was also preceded in death by her beloved husband, Douglas William Lozel.

Stephanie dedicated much of her life to education, working as a librarian for the Henry County Public Schools until her retirement.
