Virginia Hendry Rountree, of Riverdale, Georgia, passed away August 3, 2013, in Atlanta after a brief illness. Virginia-"Jenny" as she was fondly known by all her friends and family, was born October 23, 1924 in Washington, Georgia. She was the daughter of the late James Hart Hendry and Georgia M. Jackson.
